Subject: Music

Procedure:

Students will be put in groups of 3 for this project

Students will be given a genre of 20th Century music to compose a selection from

(serialism, minimalism, jazz, etc.)

Students will use flat.io to write their music piece in proper notation – they will use it

simultaneously so they can all edit the score together on individual computers

public concert

Computer with Internet access as well as Skype, Google Hangouts, etc.
